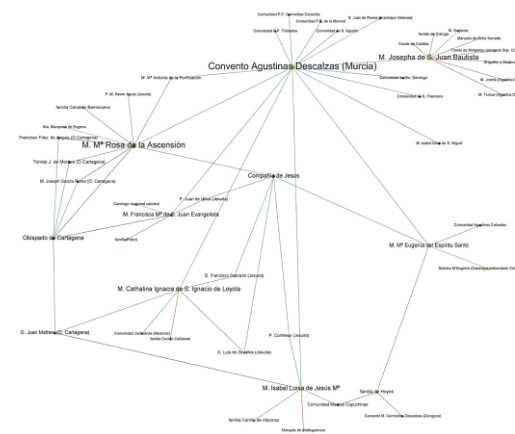
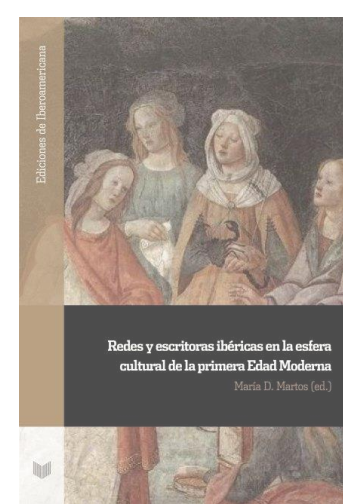
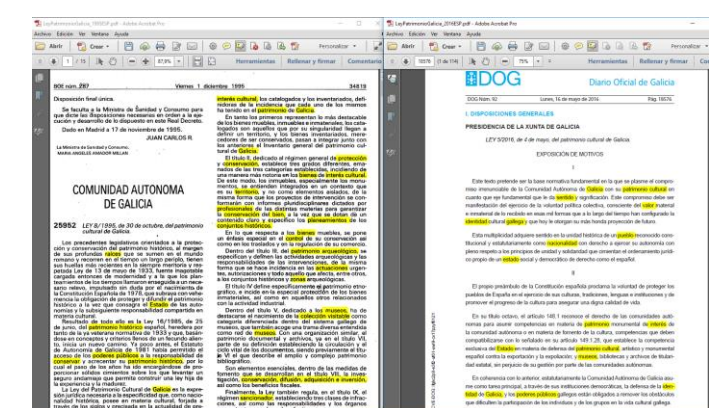

OBXECTIVOS E TEMÁTICAS

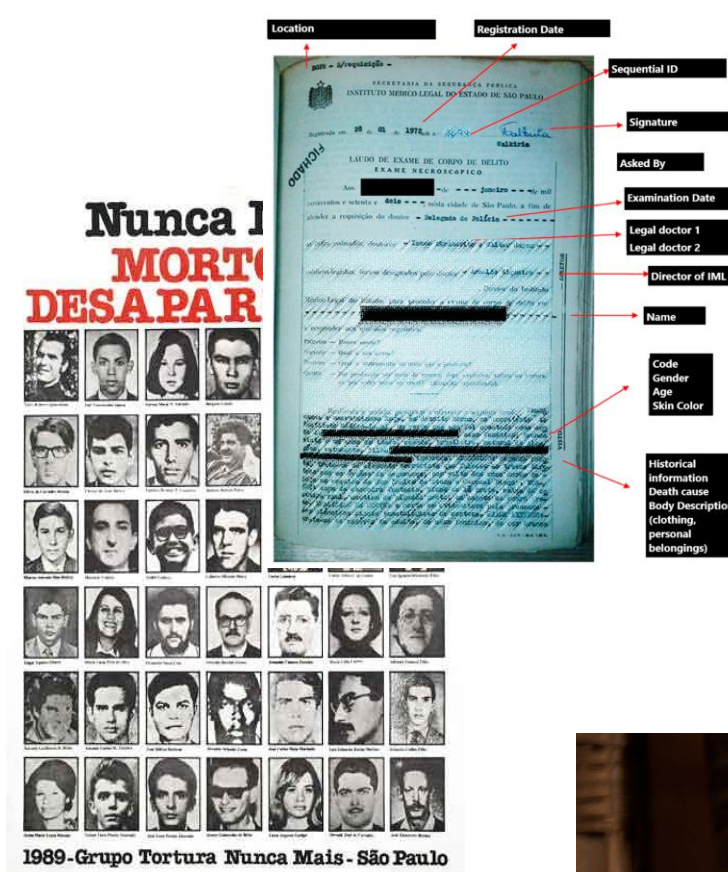
- Estudio transdisciplinar de fenómenos de memoria, identidade e patrimonio.
