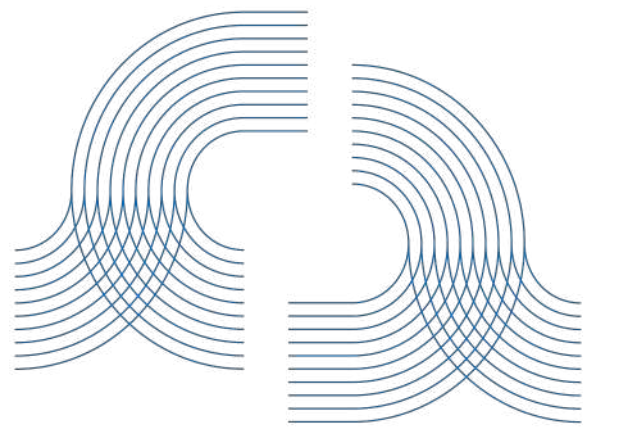

The Vigo Corpus of Learner Spoken English, VICOLSE, is a collection of real samples of spoken English produced by Galician students of English as a foreign language at the University of Vigo.
- VIGO CORPUS OF LEARNER SPOKEN ENGLISH**
DATA
VICOLSE consists of a 100,000 word time-aligned spoken corpus of learner English.
- VIGO CORPUS OF LEARNER SPOKEN ENGLISH**
TOOLS
The corpus search and analysis tools will make it possible to address important research questions about the acquisition of English by Spanish/Galician learners.
